# UNWRAPPING THE GIFT

# an Advent-Focused Family Gathering

This Advent Gathering focuses on Jesus being the best gift we receive each Christmas. The activities point us to the excitement of Jesus's upcoming Birthday. This is experienced through family conversations, prayer, activities, and practical reflections. It is our hope that families leave this event with their eyes and hearts focused on the deeper meaning of Christmas as they begin to anticipate the glory and joy the gift of Jesus brings.

### **BEST PRACTICES + TIPS**

- + We suggest 1.5-2 hours for this event.
- + Gather a team together to help support you with this event. You will need people to help with marketing, environment, hospitality, check-in, hosting a station, set-up, and clean-up.
- + Provide hospitality cake or snacks, birthday party/celebration decor, Advent wreath, and a welcoming environment.

#### PREPARATION FOR EVENT

#### PREPARATION:

Each station includes a supply list and preparation tasks to be completed before the event. A station script is also provided to help the team members who will be leading the activities.

#### PRAYER TABLE:

Consider creating a prayer table at the front or center of your gathering space. You may decide to include an Advent wreath, candles, purple cloth, a cross, etc.

#### STATIONS:

We recommend choosing four stations depending on your time frame, space, and number of people. We have included five stations so that you may choose based on budget, location, needs, etc.

#### NAMES OF STATIONS:

- 1. The Invitation
- 2. Time to Prepare
- 3. Who We Celebrate
- 4. Candles and Cake
- 5. The Gift

#### **EVENT SCRIPT**

#### PREPARATION:

- +Gather a few presents you have received and put them in boxes.
- +Place the manger at the front/center of the gathering space.

#### SUPPLY LIST:

- +Straw (Have enough for each person to have a few pieces)
- +Manger
- +Candles
- +Bags (One per family to carry their creations from the event)
- +Instrumental music for prayer experience

#### **OPENING COMMENTS:**

Welcome to our celebration! We are thrilled that your family has joined us. We are getting ready to meet baby Jesus, who will soon be born into our lives again this Christmas. We call this time of preparation—Advent. The word Advent means "coming" or "waiting."

#### OPENING PRAYER:

To be read by a family

Jesus, We are excited to prepare for your birth today! Thank you for this time with other families who have come to be close to you. Help us to remember that you are the greatest gift we will receive this Christmas. Amen.

Today we will be using the theme "Unwrapping the Gift" as we participate in different activities pointing us to Jesus's birth. We can think of this time similar to that of preparing for a Birthday party for someone we love. We have all been invited to this joyous event that takes place on December 25, Christmas day! Let us each begin to prepare ourselves to be part of celebrating the birth of our greatest gift, Jesus.

December is also a time of buying and receiving gifts. We begin to notice presents wrapped under our Christmas trees. Many of these gifts we will play with for a while and then eventually tire of. We are lucky if some of these gifts make it to the next year. (Open up some boxes with clothes, a board game, perfume, etc. and talk about how excited you first were to receive each of them and yet it went out of style, you got tired of it, or you grew out of it, etc.)

But the best gift we receive, the one born on Christmas Day, will be with us forever. The wrapping paper this gift came in wasn't fancy— (bring out a manger, some straw, and light a few candles)—and this gift will always be with us. In the simple manger surrounded by candlelight, we will begin our evening by each adding a few pieces of straw to soften the bed of the gift we will soon unwrap.

Have each family come forward quietly and add a few pieces of straw to the manger. Consider playing some instrumental music.

We will now be breaking into stations as we prepare for Jesus's arrival. At each station you will participate in a short, hands-on activity. Please stay with your family. You will be put in a small group of families that you will continue to journey with throughout the event. There is no "order" so you will start at a station and then move to the next one with your group, eventually participating in all stations.

(Divide the group into groups of about 10 families—either by last name, location in the room, etc.—and give each family a bag to carry their creations from the various stations).

## STATION 1

#### THE INVITATION

#### PREPARATION:

+Print the gift tags provided. We suggest two sheets per family, so each person has multiple to create. If possible, print them on cardstock paper.

#### SUPPLY LIST:

- +Gift tags (provided)
- +Markers, colored pencils, crayons
- +Paper hole punch (multiple)
- +Ribbons
- +Cardstock paper
- +Glue

#### STATION SCRIPT:

A birthday party begins with an invitation. Our invitation to Christmas began a very long time ago as an angel appeared to a young woman named Mary and asked her to be the mother of Jesus. She must have been excited, a little afraid, and very unsure—but she said "yes" for all of us! Her whole life pointed us to the Son she loved so much.

# Activity:

We, too, can point others to Jesus and invite them into the celebration of his birth this Christmas. We will take some time to make gift tags with a Christ-filled message. Tying these onto gifts we give to others during this season is a way to share the true message of Christmas, and invite others to share in that joy!

We have provided various gift tags that can be colored and backed with cardstock paper, hole punched, and tied with ribbons. We invite you to get creative!

#### QUESTIONS TO DISCUSS AS YOU CREATE YOUR GIFT TAGS:

- +An invitation requires a response. How do you accept Jesus as an important part of your life?
  - +Do you find it difficult sometimes to make Jesus a priority in your life? If so, why?
  - +During the holidays it can be hard to stay focused on Jesus's birth. What are a few simple things you can do as a family to keep Jesus at the center?

+It's always fun to brighten someone's day! What are a few simple things you can do for others this Advent?

# SAMPLE SCHEDULE UNWRAPPING THE GIFT

#### SAMPLE SCHEDULE AND TIME FRAME:

\*Please Note: We recommend doing four stations. These stations will last ten minutes each. Approximately ten families at a station, at a time. If you have a very large group, consider having two groups per station, or offering this event twice.

6:30 pm:

Event Begins

6:30pm-6:35pm:

Families check-in, fellowship, and hospitality

6:35pm:

Opening - All families sit in chairs in the center of the room for a short introduction. Divide the group into groups of ten families (either by last name, location in the room, etc.). This will depend on how many stations you choose to do and how many families you have in attendance. One family will read the opening prayer, then everyone will move to their station.

6:45pm:

Move to first station

6:50pm:

Stations Begin

6:50-7:00pm:

Station #1

Families move to next station

7:05-7:15 p m:

Station #2

Families move to next station

7:20-7:30pm:

Station #3

Families move to next station

7:35-7:45 pm:

Station #4

Families move to closing

7:50pm-8:00pm:

Closing - Short closing in the center with a family reading the closing prayer.


