

What have I done that separates me from God? What must I change to turn back to him?







WEDNESDAY • SECOND WEEK OF ADVENT




"I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my victorious right hand." Isaiah 41:10

Give extra consideration to words that arouse a sense of yearning in your heart.




"The blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have good news brought to them."

This week pray for the courage to make a difference in the lives of people around you who are in need.





TUESDAY • THIRD WEEK OF ADVENT




"For I will leave in the midst of you a people humble and lowly.... they shall do no wrong and utter no lies."

Jesus reveals God. Observe God, and remember he made you in his image, not the other way around.




"What did you go out into the wilderness to look at? A reed shaken by the wind?"
